PUBLIC HEARING

- Amendment to Height exceptions and limitations to the Zoning Code of Bland County. The Public Hearing was opened. There were no public speakers present. The Public Hearing was closed. Discussion of the amendment was held. A motion to recommend approval for the change to read, "Fully sprinkled hotels and motels along with their accessory signage located on the same or adjoining lots within the same area, church spires, belfries, monuments, water towers, chimney, flues, flag poles, quarries, sand gravel, or crushed stone operations are exempt. An accessory structure height shall not exceed the principal structure height except for garages or farm building constructed subsequent to a residence.", was made by Commissioner Hermansen with a second provided by Commissioner Bradshaw. The motion passed unanimously.

-CUP application from the EDA for a Hotel on Tax Map Numbers 49A-A-2&3. The Public Hearing was opened. There were no public speakers present. The Public Hearing was closed. Discussion of the CUP was held. After much discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Johnson to recommend approval for the CUP for Tax Map Numbers 49A-A-2&3 with the following condition:

-The hotel/motel is to be a Business Class or higher A second was made by Commissioner Dodson. The motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

-Application for re-zoning Tax Map 77-A-24 from Agricultural to Commercial, with a CUP to operate an Auto Sales and Service, and a CUP for a dwelling. Mr. Daniels has requested to down size his operation at Brushy Mountain Motors, he wishes to make this a hobby, but keeping his DMV License. It was discussed that the Commission should schedule an on site review of the location and needs to schedule it through Mr. Cagle. A motion to hold a public hearing was made by Commissioner Dodson with a second provided by Commissioner Chewning. The motion passed unanimously.
